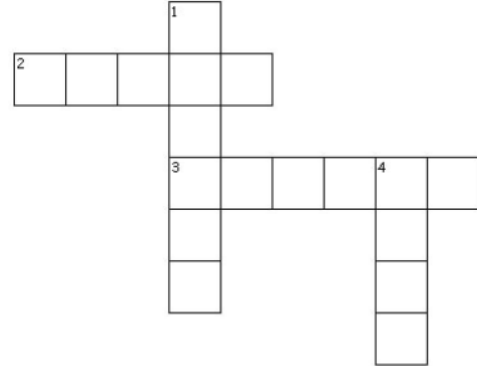
Jesus' Teachings
