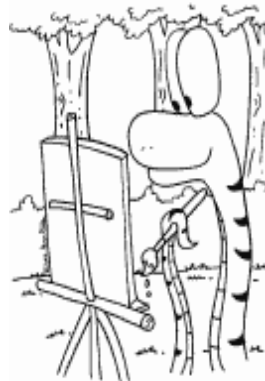
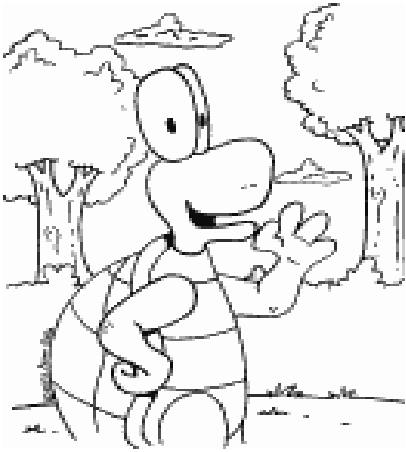
It is a time of renewal

The color symbolizes penance and reflection

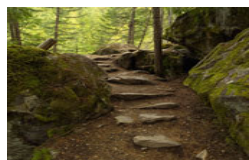

Ash Wednesday

Mary, the Mother of Jesus always thanked God when good things happened to her. Today say the Hail Mary with your parent.

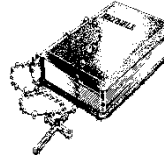
Friday 2/27
