Thursday 3/19

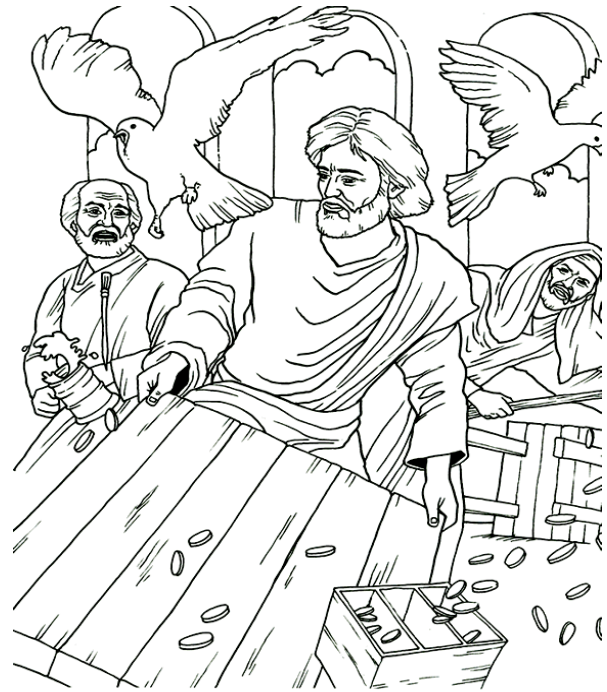
Saint Joseph was a kind and loving father to Jesus. We need to be kind and loving to the members of our family.
