- \_\_\_\_\_ **THOLOBARMEW** friend of Philip, preached the Gospel in Ethiopia, India, Persia and Armenia.
- \_\_\_\_\_ **NOJH** brother of James the Greater, called the "Beloved Disciple".
- \_\_\_\_\_ **MEJAS** brother of John, with Peter and John, witnessed the raising of Jairus' daughter to life, the transfiguration, and the agony of Jesus in the Garden of Gethsemani.
- \_\_\_\_\_ **MISON** Called the Cananean or the Zealot.
- \_\_\_\_\_ **JUED SUEDTHAD** One of the Catholic Epistles, preached the Gospel in Mesopotamia, Persia and elsewhere.
- \_\_\_\_\_ **SEMJA HET SELS** called "Less" because he was younger in age or shorter in stature than James the Greater.
- \_\_\_\_\_ **THIASMA** chosen by the 11 Apostles to replace Judas before the Resurrection.
